The doctor of chiropractic degree represents a four-academic-year program of study and clinical internship.

At the ceremony, valedictorian honors went to Susan Wang of San Jose, California, for the graduating class of Summer 2010 and Julie Gray of Orangevale, California, for the graduating class of Fall 2010.
