LIFE WEST FACULTY MEMBER'S LIFE HIGHLIGHTED IN TOP CHIROPRACTIC MAGAZINE

HAYWARD, Calif. July 27, 2010 – Kim Khauv, Doctor of Chiropractic and full-time faculty instructor at Life Chiropractic College West, was the subject of a feature article in June/July issue of **Today's Chiropractic Lifestyle**. Dr. Khauv discussed his experience growing up in Cambodia in the mid-1970s.

In 1981, his family fled Cambodia after the Khmer Rouge, began an agricultural reform that led to widespread famine and genocide between 1975 and 1979. After earning his graduate degree as a doctor of chiropractic and a master's degree in public health, he began a non-profit organization, Well-Balanced World. The mission of the organization is to bring chiropractic to Cambodia. In December 2009, he led a team of twelve college interns who traveled to rural parts of Cambodia to provide chiropractic care. Dr. Khauv stated, "In certain places, we were there for three days at a time, and there are some who would come all three days, and even bring their children and friends. It was a beautiful thing to see."

Life West, established in 1976, is an accredited non-profit institution of higher learning. Currently over 400 students from across the United States and abroad are enrolled, and over 3,700 graduates of Life West are now providing chiropractic care worldwide. The college's Health Center, a public outpatient facility, staffed by approximately 150 senior interns who are guided by licensed doctors of chiropractic, provides affordable health care to more than 1,500 patients per week in the city of Hayward, California.
